### **WHAT ELSE COMES WITH THE CHROMEBOOK?**

In order to manage the overall risk, our insurance company requires devices to be outfitted with a protective case. Cosmetic damage and scratches are not covered by the policy, only accidental damage that affects the functionality of the computer. **Students who do not use the protective case may be subject to disciplinary action on their campus as well as risk of having insurance claims denied.**

In addition, the LionCare Device Protection Plan will include a deductible on claims this year. On the second claim, students/parents will be responsible for a \$25 deductible to initiate a claim. Our hope is students will build a sense of ownership and take better care of their device.
